Reminder: Free Influenza Program has concluded


The Free Influenza Vaccination Program officially concluded yesterday. The program webpage has been updated to include important information regarding reimbursement procedures.

To support providers, letters outlining reimbursement details for privately purchased vaccines administered under the program between 1-31 July have been distributed via the WA Department of Health to all vaccine ordering account holders.

Key Points:

- Only influenza vaccines administered during May to July 2025 in line with the conditions of the Free Influenza Vaccination Program are eligible for reimbursement.
- Any unused influenza vaccine stock that was purchased privately will not be reimbursed.
- Excess government-funded stock may continue to be used until its expiry date, in accordance with standard practice, however the Department of Health will not provide administration reimbursements. Immunisation providers must not charge patients a fee for the cost of the vaccine
