# **Discharge Ward**

Open Monday to Friday, 8am-5.30pm

This area welcomes patients for completion of care before discharge home or transfer to another facility for ongoing care.

We are committed to ensuring every patient is comfortable and provided with the highest level of nursing care while completing the final aspects of the discharge process.

During your stay in the Discharge Ward, you may be waiting for:

- Discharge education
- Discharge letter
- Medical information, including follow-up appointments
- Medications/scripts
- Medical certificate
- Transport
- Final nursing care, eg: wound care, intravenous antibiotics
- Final review by Allied Health/Outpatient Service

During your stay, please do not hesitate to discuss any concerns with your nurse.

On your day of discharge, if you are being transferred to the Discharge Ward, await confirmation from the nurses in this area prior to notifying your transport home.

### Services and amenities available

Dedicated nurses will help you access:

- Comfortable seats (including recliners or high-backed chairs)
- Beds
- Shower and toilet facilities.
- Hot and cold refreshments
- Light meals and snacks
- Television, magazines and books
- Phone.

# **Collection from the Discharge Ward**

The Discharge Ward is located on the ground floor of E Block in Sir Charles Gairdner Hospital.

Do not park in the multi-storey carpark accessed on Thomas Street.

The Discharge Ward offers drive-through collection via the external entrance at Bandak Loop, on the corner of Verdun Street and Gairdner Drive.

There are 10-minute parking bays at the entrance where patients can be assisted to the car.

All patients must be collected by 5.30pm.


